Analysis

- Most funding for the foundation is derived from gifts from family company Inc. There are no personal contributions to the corpus from individual family members. This may indicate the objective of the foundation is more business related than outwardly assumed

- Relatively new Executive Director was a fundraiser for xxx and xxx and did communications work for xxx
